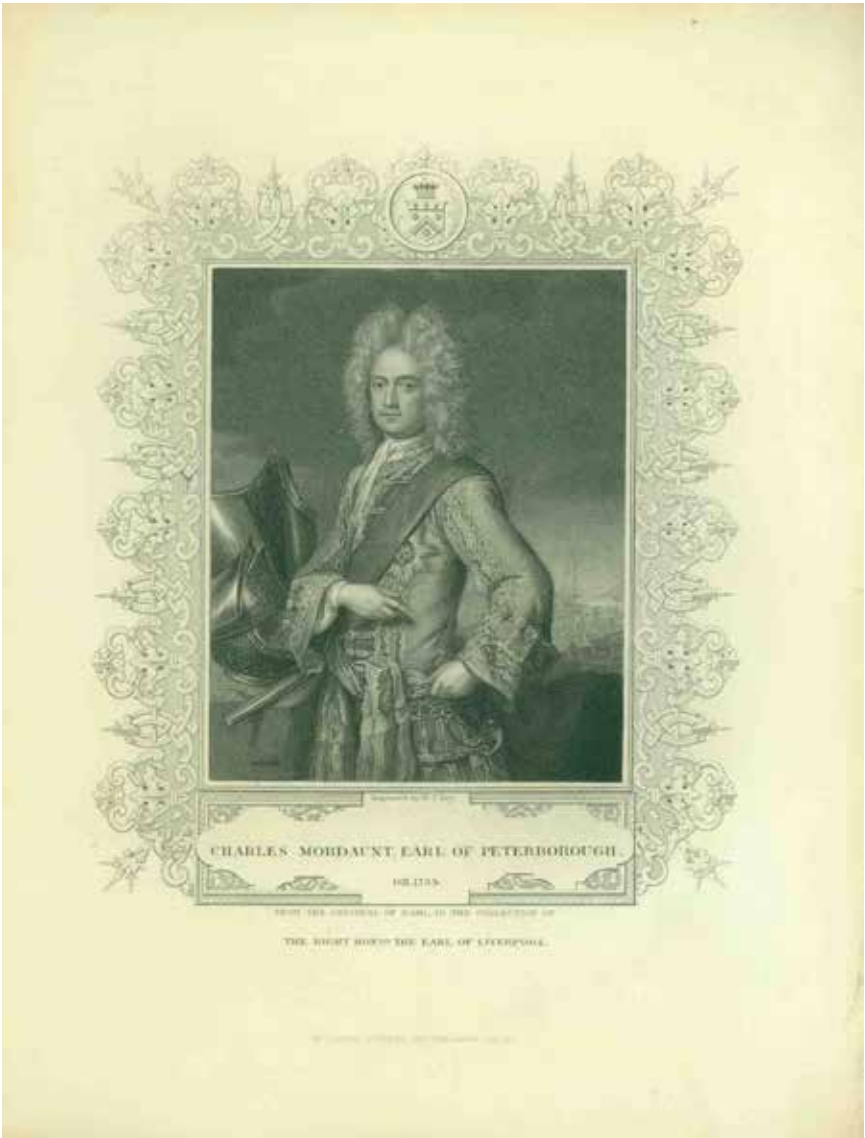


57 **Portrait: WILLIAM CAVENDISH, FIRST DUKE OF DEVONSHIRE.**

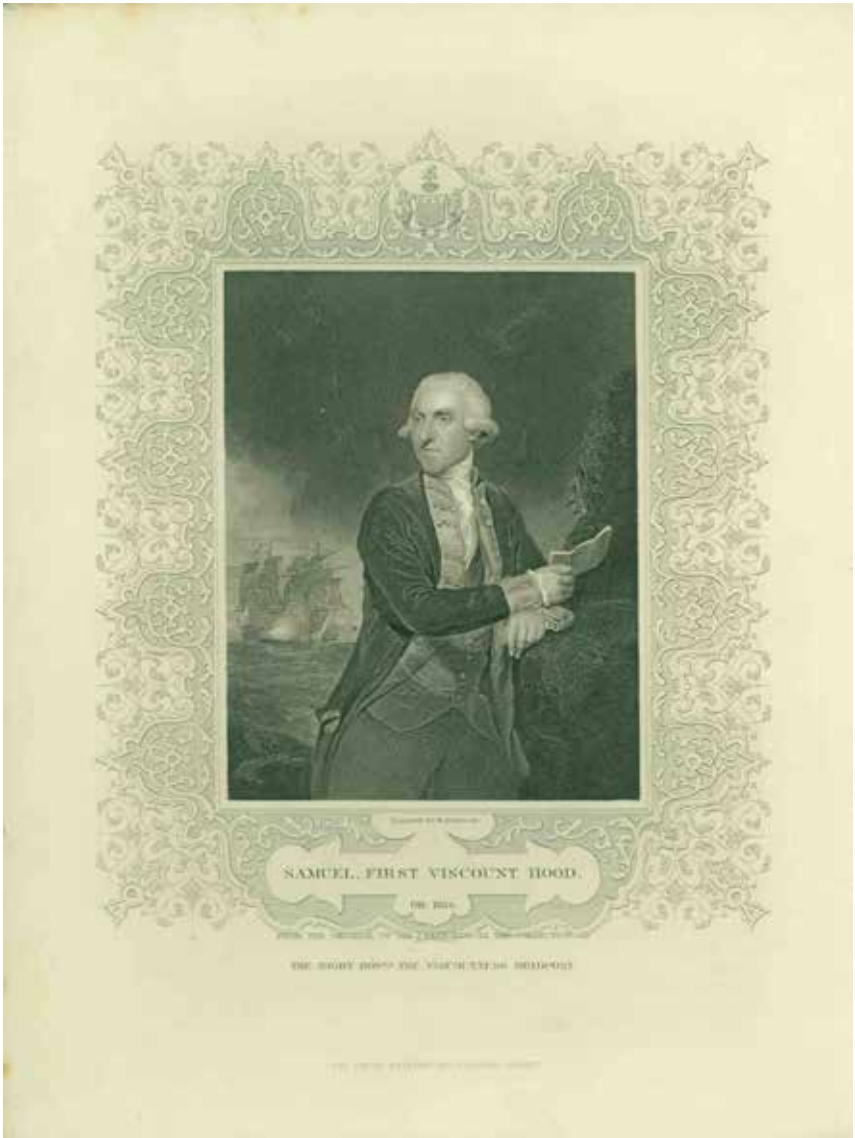
