In our opinion this rather sells many of them short, which the book itself does not! Included are many accounts relating to 'Terra Australis' or to an undiscovered 'Southland'. There is extensive biographical information on the writers and the imaginary travellers as well as their historical background. The text is fully cross-referenced and in addition, as for the first four volumes, each article contains a bibliography of both primary and secondary sources (in many cases quite extensive).*

Much of the information is here published for the first time in English and there are numerous entries covering obscure but real persons as well as obscure and unnoticed works of fiction which would be extremely difficult to research without this invaluable tool.
